REDS

The Whole Pod

Syrah Merlot 2016, R96: seductively complex and full-flavoured, this lovely wine has dark berries, oak and violets in its depths.

Mensa Cabernet

Sauvignon 2017, R85: laid back and gentle on the tongue, this well-rounded wine stands its own.

Protea Shiraz 2017, R60:

Protea is a great range of very affordable wines, and this smoky, earthy wine is a wonderful example.

Rooiberg Cabernet

Sauvignon / Merlot 2017, R52: light in colour and subtle in taste, this is good both warm and chilled.

Arabella Pinotage 2017,

R53: rounded with lots of fruit and a hint of smoke.

Kleine Zalze Cellar

Selection Merlot 2017, R77: juicy and ripe with a full-flavoured finish, this will keep well too.



Waterkloof Estate

Revenant Red, R100:

a truly beautiful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cinsault, this is both subtle and richly satisfying ... there's a touch of chocolate too!

Zonnebloem Shiraz Mourvèdre Viognier 2016, R86:

woody and smooth, this finely balanced blend has notes of stone fruit and berry.

Anura Pinotage

Syrah 2016, R73.50:

a dark, spicy, exciting blend that really delivers on flavour. Only 2.2gm/l Residual Sugar!

Balance Winemaker's

Selection Chenin Blanc

2018, R62: easy drinking and – I know, I know, but it really is – beautifully balanced.

Grande Provence Chenin

Blanc 2017, R90: light and elegant, this is a lovely addition to any meal.

Alvi's Drift ADS Chenin Blanc

2018, R50: really excellent value – and look out for their Sauvignon Blanc too, it's fab.

Bellingham Homestead

Sauvignon Blanc 2018, R80:

dry and steely, this has a splash of citrus and soft melon.

Babylorestoren Chenin Blanc

2018, R86: vibrant and refreshing, with subtle accents of guava and melon.

Alée Bleue Sauvignon

Blanc 2018, R70: crisp and dry, with green fruit flavours coming through.

Fryer's Cove Doringbay

Sauvignon Blanc 2018, R95: such a good buy! This is dry and delicious; truly without being at all sweet. I love the label, too.

Durbanville Hills Chardonnay

2017, R65: zesty and fresh, this also manages to taste creamy and luxurious. An excellent go-

to wine.

Cape Town Wine

Co Chardonnay 2018, R80: crisply delicious, it's flavourful and elegant.

Blue Owl

Chardonnay 2018, R50: tasty but simple, this easy-drinker definitely does the trick. ✦
